The Background:

The Missions Hub is purposed to support and encourage Christian Mission in Canada and around the world. Located at Knox Church, in downtown Toronto, the Missions Hub is bringing together Missionaries, Missions agencies and Churches to work together for the Kingdom. In its first year of operation, the Missions Hub has involved 30+ missions agencies, supported hundreds of Missionaries/Supporters, and engaged thousands of students. By providing co-working space, and hosting events, trainings, prayer days, and meetings, the Missions Hub has given us an exciting glimpse of what can be accomplished when we work together in God's Global Mission (missionshub.ca)

We want to build on the passionate work that is happening at the Missions Hub by focusing very intentionally on mobilization. We recognize the opportunity on our doorstep - 700,000 people live in downtown Toronto. The largest age group is between 25-34 years old. 58,000 students are enrolled in the University of Toronto St. George, located literally across the street from the Missions Hub. Five missions agencies and one church (OMF, TEAM, SIM, AVANT, Wycliffe Bible Translators, Knox World Mission), working together through the Missions Hub to collaborate with multiple other missions agencies, churches and campus groups, see the amazing Kingdom potential here and the strength that comes when we work through the unity we have in Christ.

The goal of the Missions Hub is to creatively champion and encourage mission by bringing together missionaries, missions agencies and those interested in missions. The hope, dream, and prayer is that the Missions Hub will be a catalyst for missional engagement.

The Missions Hub Internship Position Overview:

The Missions Hub Intern will build upon and strengthen that which is happening at the Missions Hub. Working closely with the Missions Hub Mobilization Coordinator, this individual will be trained to perform core responsibilities, given opportunity to grow in key qualities, and become well-versed in the art of mobilization. There will be strong components of both mentorship and learning-in-process within this role.

Core Responsibilities:

- Grow in your understanding of global missions and global church growth
- Co-facilitate and support collaboration between Global Missions Agencies, Campus Ministries, Toronto Churches and other Christian groups
- Champion Missions in Toronto & meet with individuals who are interested in the vision / initiative
- Represent the Missions Hub and learn about our close partners: OMF, TEAM, SIM, AVANT, Wycliffe Bible Translators, Knox World Mission
- Mobilize young people in downtown Toronto to serve in global missions
- Develop and Manage a Social Media Strategy (Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, Facebook)
- Coordinate and facilitate Missions Hub Events
- Co-develop a curriculum for helping missions workers relate to millennials and GenZ
- Report on a bi-weekly basis to Missions Hub Staff

Key Qualities for this Position:

- A servant's heart: Someone who thrives on supporting and building up other people / groups
- A learner's attitude: someone who has an appreciation and growing understanding of missions
- A relationship-builder: Someone who understands Kingdom values and how to engage people in mission
- An initiative taker: Someone who can work independently, while submitting to leadership and working in a team; Someone who has a great capacity for juggling multiple balls and wearing multiple hats

- An individual with strong communication skills: Someone with strong written, oral and digital communications skills who is comfortable publicly representing the Missions Hub (VIA online channels, in person, making presentations, etc.)
- A drive to succeed : Someone with an incredible determination, commitment and passion for serving Jesus
- A university student enrolled at U of T St. George for the fall semester
- Previous experience with and a commitment to a campus group ministry
